We provide assistance to individuals affected by debts which are being enforced, or at risk of being enforced in court, and legal advice in areas of:

- · consumer law and fair trading
- consumer credit (personal loans, credit cards, mortgages etc)
- bankruptcy; and
- the provision of telecommunications services and other utilities.

Clinic lawyers will not provide advice on matters which involve the Commonwealth of Australia (eg a debt owed to the ATO or Centrelink) or if they are business related.

We can provide information, referrals and legal advice about your rights.

We can also assist with the preparation of Statement of Financial Affairs or other court documents and negotiations with creditors.
