- The amount of the fee varies depending on how many days the matter will take.
- The hearing fee is to be paid by the applicant unless the ACAT ordersotherwise.
- The hearing fee must be paid within seven days of the ACAT setting the hearing dates.
- Additional daily fees are payable for each day that the hearing goes beyond the estimate.
- These fees must be paid by the earlier of (a) when the ACAT allocates the extra hearing days; or (b) at the end of the hearing (whichever occurs first).
- If the case is settled or adjourned twenty-eight days or more before the hearing dates, 75% of the fee is refundable.

- If the case is settled or adjourned fourteen days or more before the hearing date, 50% of the fee is refundable.
- Fees paid for a hearing that is adjourned before commencement, due to circumstances beyond the control of the parties, can be transferred to the new hearing dates or refunded.
- If a hearing is adjourned after commencement, due to circumstances beyond the control of the parties, fees paid for hearing dates scheduled after the adjournment, can be transferred to the new hearing dates or refunded.
